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The Climate Information Prize (CIP) is funded by UK Aid in partnership with the Kenya Meteorological Department (KMD). CIP has been set up to incentivise the development of innovative solutions to make climate information more useable and accessible for vulnerable individuals, households and communities in Kenya.

Winning initiatives will put vulnerable individuals and households in control and enable them to access the information they need in order to better tackle climate uncertainty and risk.

CIP currently consists of two types of prizes. First, the Wazo (ideas) Prize, a cash prize award with a particular focus on the recognition, showcasing, and publicity of innovative ideas in the area of climate information. Second, the Tekeleza (implementation) Prize. This is the main award of the prize programme and will be awarded to the best applicants who have implemented their initiatives on-the-ground over several years, and can demonstrate the highest impact across a number of indicators.
