Eco-Frontier has established a Climate Smart Agriculture Resource Centre aimed at providing a triple dividend for smallholders by 1) providing and communicating climate and weather information; 2) serving as a demonstration and learning centre for climate smart agriculture (CSA) practice; and 3) providing leadership in production of high value crops and linking informal value-chains to urban markets.

Our flagship centre addresses the information and technology challenges that smallholder farmers face when transitioning to CSA. For the target communities', access to climate information coupled with CSA practice is intended to reduce their vulnerability by 1) helping to direct the planning, investment and decision making that is required for climate-resilience by smallholders and 2) improving awareness on the impacts of climate change, which will likely lead to targeted actions to reduce negative impacts and enhance income generation and food security.

CIP awards cash prizes to incentivise the development of innovative solutions and make climate information more accessible and useable for vulnerable individuals, households and communities.
